School Spectacular Policy

- 1. The school acknowledges that involvement in Schools Spectacular can be of benefit to certain Conservatorium High students when it complements existing CHS activities.**
- 2. Students in Yrs 7 - 10 may be considered for involvement in Schools Spectacular if the timing does not negatively affect their musical and/or academic commitments at school.**
- 3. Students in Yr 11 will only be considered for involvement in Schools Spectacular if they are either a Featured Artist or the Concert Master. The musical outcomes of Schools Spectacular are NOT more important than the educational experiences and obligations/commitments of being a House leader (House Concerts are being managed at the time of Schools Spectacular and ALL of Yr 11 are leading these rehearsals)**
- 4. Any student wishing to be considered for Schools Spectacular must submit a written request to the Principal outlining why this experience has greater educational value than the CHS House Concerts program taking place that week, and what measures they have taken and will take to negate any negative educational impact missing week of school will have.**
- 5. Any student wishing to be considered for Schools Spectacular must seek approval from his/her House Captains to be absent for the whole week.**
- 6. Any student wishing to be considered for Schools Spectacular must have demonstrated consistent and diligent application to ALL school subjects, be up-to-date with Assessments, homework and in-school academic and musical "minimum requirements".**
- 7. Only in exceptional circumstances will a Yr 11 or Yr 12 student who is undertaking the HSC Music 2 Course in Term 4, or is accelerated into an HSC course, be given permission to participate in Schools Spectacular.**
